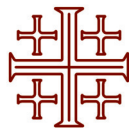

THE ORDER FOR SUNG EUCHARIST

OPENING HYMN

INVOCATION

P: In the name of the Father, and of the ✠ Son,
and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen

P: Beloved in the Lord, let us draw near with a true heart
and confess our sins to God our Father, imploring Him in
the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness.

C: Let us rejoice and be glad in it.

P: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

C: Who made heaven and earth.

P: I said I will confess my transgressions to the Lord,

C: And you forgave the iniquity of my sins.

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves and the
truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God is faithful
and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all
unrighteousness. *(1 John 1:6-9)* Let us humble ourselves
before the Almighty God and confess our sins.

CONFESSION OF OUR SINS

**C: O Almighty God, merciful Father, I confess to You all
my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended
You and justly deserve Your punishment now and
forever. I am sincerely sorry for them and sincerely
repent of them, and I pray to You for Your boundless
mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent and bitter
sufferings and death of Your beloved Son Jesus Christ,
to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor sinful being.**

ABSOLUTION

P: Upon this your confession, I as a called and ordained servant of Jesus Christ, announce the grace of God to all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ pronounce that all of your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father, and of the ✠ Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen

The KYRIE is said or sung

C: Lord have mercy upon us,
Christ have mercy upon us,
Lord have mercy upon us.

The GLORIA is said or sung

C: Glory to God on high and peace to all on earth.
We worship You, we give You thanks, our heavenly King.
We give You praise, Almighty God and Father blessed,
In glory bright.

**Our Saviour Jesus Christ, the Father's only Son.
The sacrificial Lamb who saves the world from sin.
Have mercy Lord, beside the Father's hand enthroned,
Now hear our prayer.**

**You are the only Lord, You only are most high.
You only are the Holy One, Lord Jesus Christ.
And now You reign, with Father and with Spirit One,
In glorious light.**

The SALUTATION and COLLECT

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

The OLD TESTAMENT and EPISTLE

After each reading the minister says:

P: This is the word of the Lord C: Amen

The HOLY GOSPEL

P: The Holy Gospel according to. C: Glory to You, O Lord

After the reading of the Gospel the minister says:

P: This is the Gospel of our Lord C: Praise to You, O Christ

The NICENE CREED

C: I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried. And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. And He will come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom will have no end.

And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of Life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets.

And I believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church, I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

PRAYERS for the Church, the World and the People

The PREFACE to the Lord's Supper

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

P: Lift up your hearts.

C: We lift them up unto the Lord.

P: Let us give thanks unto the Lord our God.

C: It is good and right so to do.

P: It is truly good, right and salutary that we should at all times and in all places give thanks unto You O Lord, Holy Father, Almighty and Everlasting God through Jesus Christ our Lord, who on this day overcame death and the grave by His glorious resurrection opened to us the way of everlasting life.

Therefore with angels and archangels and with all the company of heaven, we laud and magnify Your glorious name, evermore praising You and saying:

The SANCTUS is sung or said:

**C: Holy, holy, holy Lord God of Hosts,
Heaven and earth are full of Your glory.
Glory be to You, O Lord Most High.
Blessed is He that comes in name of the Lord,
Hosanna in the highest.**

P: Hear us O Holy and merciful Father,
We most humbly beg You. Grant that we receiving
the Holy and blessed Sacrament, according to Your Son
our Saviour Jesus Christ's Holy institution, may we
faithfully eat His Body and drink His Blood
for the forgiveness, renewal and strengthening of our
bodies and souls as He bids us in His own Testament.

The EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

P: Almighty and merciful God, great is the majesty of Your
glory. You so loved the world that You gave Your only Son,
that whoever believes in Him may not perish but have
eternal life. Having come into the world, He fulfilled Your
holy will and accomplished our salvation.

Remembering, His life-giving Passion and death, His
glorious resurrection and ascension, and His promise to
come again, we give thanks to You Lord God Almighty,
and implore You to accept our praise and thanksgiving,
and by Your Word and Holy Spirit bless all Your servants
who share in the Body and Blood of Your Son. May they
be filled with heavenly peace and joy, and receiving the
forgiveness of sin, may be sanctified in soul and body, and
share in fellowship with all Your saints.

C: Amen

The LORD'S PRAYER

**C: Our Father who art in heaven,
Hallowed be Thy Name, Thy kingdom come,
Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread;
And forgive us our trespasses,
As we forgive those who trespass against us;
And lead us not into temptation,
But deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory,
For ever and ever. Amen.**

The WORDS OF INSTITUTION

P: Our Lord Jesus Christ, on the night when He was betrayed, took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to His disciples and said, 'Take, eat; this is My ✠ Body, given for you. This do in remembrance of me.'

In the same way, also He took the cup after supper, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them saying, 'Drink of it all of you. This cup is the New Testament in My ✠ Blood, Shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. This do as often as you drink it in remembrance of Me.'

The PRAYER OF HUMILITY

P: We do not presume to come to this Your table O merciful Lord trusting in our own righteousness, but in Your many and great mercies. We are not worthy so much as to gather up the crumbs under Your table. But You are the same Lord whose property is always to have mercy. Grant us therefore gracious Lord, so to eat the flesh of Your dear Son Jesus Christ and to drink His blood, that our sinful bodies may be made clean by His Body and our souls washed through His most precious Blood, and that we may evermore dwell in Him and He in us. Amen

The PEACE is said

P: The peace of the ☩ Lord be always with you.

C: Amen

The AGNUS DEI is sung or said

**C: O Lamb of God that takest away the sin of the world,
Have mercy upon us.**

**O Lamb of God that takest away the sin of the world,
Have mercy upon us.**

**O Lamb of God that takest away the sin of the world,
Grant us Thy peace. Amen.**

The DISTRIBUTION of the Holy Sacrament

P: Take and eat, this is the true Body of our Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ given unto death for your sins.

P: Take and drink, this is the true Blood of our Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ shed for the forgiveness of your sins.

The faithful return to their seats after the following blessing.

P: The Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ preserve
your bodies and souls to life everlasting.

C: Amen.

Following the distribution of the Holy Sacrament

The NUNC DIMITTUS is said or sung:

**C: O Lord now let Your servant depart in heavenly peace,
For I have seen the glory of Your redeeming grace,
A light to lead the Gentiles, unto your Holy hill,
The glory of Your people, Your chosen Israel.**

**All glory to the Father, all glory to the Son,
All glory to the Spirit, forever Three in One,
For as in the beginning, is now, shall ever be,
God's Holy Name resounding through all eternity.**

POST COMMUNION PRAYERS

P: O, Give thanks to the Lord for He is good.

C: And His mercy endures forever.

P: Almighty God, the fountain and source of all goodness, who in loving kindness sent Your only begotten Son in the flesh, we thank You that for His sake You have given us pardon and peace in this sacrament, and we ask You not to forsake Your children but always to rule our hearts and minds by Your Holy Spirit that we may be enabled to serve You constantly, through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, One God, now and forever.

C: Amen.

P: The Lord be with you.

C. Amen

P: Let us bless the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

The BENEDICTION and BLESSING

P: The peace of God which passes all understanding, keep your hearts and minds in the knowledge and love of God and of His Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

And the blessing of God Almighty, the Father,
the ☩ Son, and the Holy Spirit be amongst you
and remain with you always.

C: Amen.
